Guided Tours

The following guided tours are available for a fee. Please inquire at Guest Relations for more details or to join a tour. Guests who have made a reservation for one of the Disney Hotels through the Reservations Center can make reservations in advance for any tour; all other Guests are asked to make reservations on the day of their visit. Prices vary depending on the tour. Cancellations on the day of the tour may result in a cancellation charge.

● Standard Tour — “Seven Seas Overview”

Perfect for first-time Guests, this tour provides basic information about the Park and each port of call. Tour Length: about 90 minutes. English speaking guides are subject to availability.

● Premium Tour — “DisneySea Discovery”

A personalized tour which allows you to focus on particular areas or aspects of the Park. You can even create your own tour with perks like FASTPASS tickets and exclusive viewing areas for shows. Some extra fees may apply. Tour length: about 3 hours. English speaking guides are subject to availability.

● DisneySea Academy — “Let's Entertain!”

This tour allows Guests the opportunity to appear as extras in a show, performed at the Dockside Stage in American Waterfront. Tour length: about 100 minutes. Japanese language only.

● Kids' Tour — “Search for the Lost Treasure”

Children are guided on an imaginative adventure through the Park in search of a mysterious treasure. Tour length: about two and a half hours. Tour subject to availability; Japanese language only.



Tokyo DisneySea Information

Located in Tokyo DisneySea Station, this facility provides general information on the Park, including attractions and shows. Lost-and-found inquiries, currency exchange, and sales of gift cards are also handled here.



Group Sales

Groups of 25 or more Guests may purchase special value group Passports here. Advance tickets (up to two months prior to visit), gift cards, and meal vouchers are also available. Tickets can be changed to a different type here.



Park Information Board

Displays attraction wait-times and scheduled start times for shows.



Lost Children

Facility for the care of children age 11 and younger who become separated from their guardians. This facility is in contact with other facilities inside and outside the Park to ensure prompt reunion of child and guardian.



Baby Center

Facilities for nursing infants, preparing infant meals, and changing diapers. A selection of formula, baby food, and disposable diapers is sold here. All women's restrooms in the Park are equipped with changing tables.

Public Telephones

Telephones are located throughout the Park. International calls may be made from phones accepting telephone cards (available in the Park).

Located throughout the Park. Letters posted here are imprinted with a commemorative design and delivered to the post office. Postage stamps are available at shops near the mailboxes.



Smoking Areas

For courtesy and the safety of all Guests, please smoke only in the designated smoking areas with ashtrays. During high attendance, ashtrays may be temporarily removed.



Card Banking (Sumitomo Mitsui Banking Corporation)

Cash dispensers for certain credit cards and bank cards are located at DisneySea Plaza. Hours: 8:00 a.m. – 9:00 p.m. daily


Credit Cards

Major credit cards are accepted throughout the Park. However, credit cards are NOT accepted:

- At balloon vendors or merchandise/food carts.
- At the parking area toll plaza.
- For purchasing stamps, gift cards, meal vouchers, telephone cards, etc.

JCB Card is the official card of Tokyo DisneySea.

Home Delivery Service

Items purchased in the Park (with some exceptions) may be shipped within Japan or to some overseas destinations for a fee. Limited service is available at shops with -mark upon request at the cashier.

Photo Terrace

While visiting the Park, you may leave your dog or cat here for a ¥2,800 fee per pet (for the day of visit only; must possess valid ID). Only Assistance Dogs are allowed inside the Park.

- Valid only at the designated attraction.
- Each FASTPASS ticket admits one Guest only. When getting FASTPASS tickets for everyone in your group, please bring each member's Passport.
- To get a FASTPASS ticket, you must have a valid Passport used for admission on the day of your visit.
- Only one FASTPASS ticket is issued at a time.
- Check your FASTPASS ticket to find out when you can get a FASTPASS for another attraction. Please note that you cannot get a second FASTPASS ticket for the same attraction until after the period of time for using the first ticket has passed.

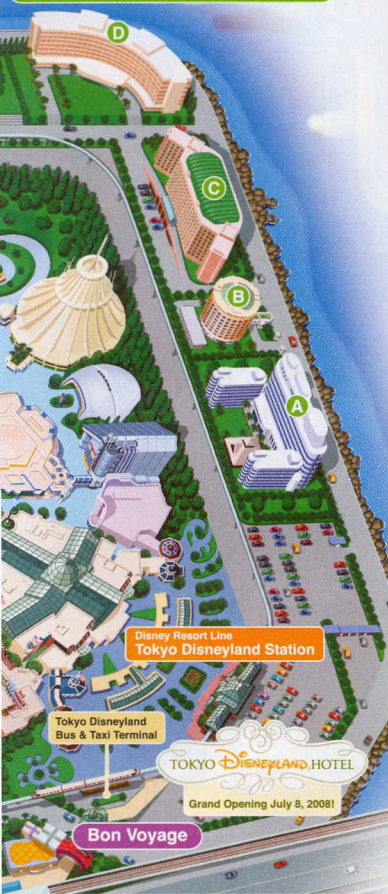
