The standard 2.5-hour tour in Japanese of the Park includes reserved viewing of a show or parade among other benefits. Adults/Juniors: ¥3,000 Children (ages 4-11): ¥1,500 Special seasonal tours in Japanese are also available. For more details and to reserve a tour, please go to Main Street House.

The East Gate Guest Reception

General information on the Park, including attractions and shows, is available here. Lost-and-found inquiries are also handled here. Located outside the Main Entrance.

Guest Relations Window

Inside the Park Currency exchange and ticket type changes are handled here. Gift cards can also be purchased.

Outside the Park Advance tickets (available up to two months before date of Park visit), Annual Passport vouchers, and Tokyo Disney Resort Gift Cards can be purchased here. Guest Relations also handles foreign currency exchange and change of ticket type.

Group Sales Window

Groups of 25 or more Guests may purchase special value group Passports here. Gift cards and meal vouchers are also available. Tickets can be changed to a different type here.

Park Information Board

Displays attraction wait-times and scheduled start times for shows. See the map on page 1.

Lost Children

Facility for the care of children age 11 and younger who become separated from their guardians. This facility is in contact with other facilities in the Park to ensure prompt reunion of child and guardian.

Baby Center Toontown Baby Center

Facilities for nursing infants, preparing infant meals, and changing diapers. A selection of formula, baby food, and disposable diapers is sold here. Most women's restrooms in the Park are equipped with changing tables (please see a Cast Member for locations).

Coin-operated storage lockers are located in two areas inside the Main Entrance and four areas outside. Belongings must be claimed at Park closing on the day of rental.

Public Telephones

Telephones are located throughout the Park. International calls may be made from phones accepting telephone cards (available in the Park).

Mailboxes

Located throughout the Park. Letters posted here are imprinted with a commemorative design and delivered to the post office. Postage stamps are available at shops near the mailboxes.

Smoking Areas

For courtesy and the safety of all Guests, please smoke only in the designated smoking areas with ashtrays. During high attendance, ashtrays may be temporarily removed.

Banking Services

The transaction counter of SMBC (Sumitomo Mitsui Banking Corporation) is open from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. (closed weekends and holidays). ATMs accepting Japanese bank cash cards operate from 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. daily.

Foreign Currency Exchange

Major foreign currencies and traveler's checks can be exchanged at:

- Guest Relations Window (outside the Main Entrance)
- SMBC in World Bazaar (when the transaction counter is open)

Credit Cards

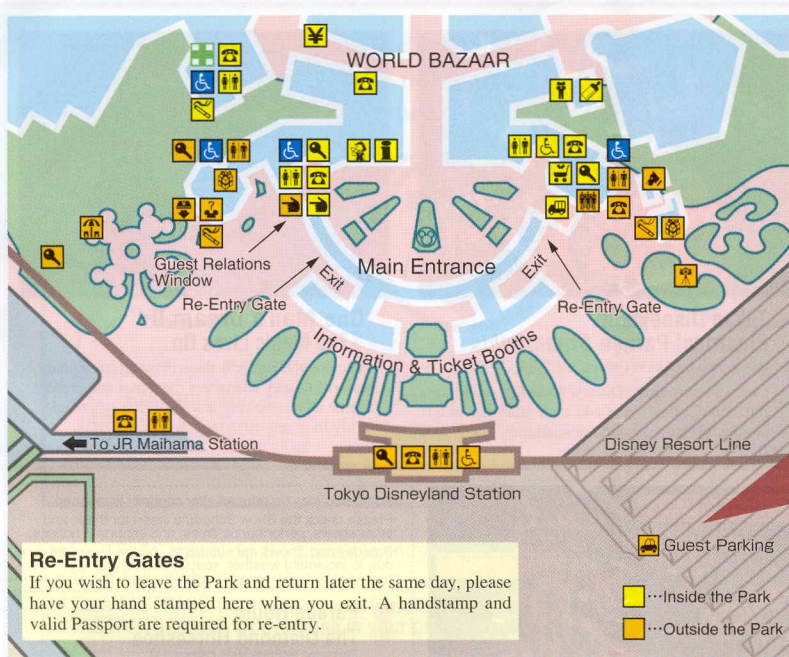
Major credit cards are accepted throughout the Park. However, credit cards are NOT accepted:

- For purchasing stamps, gift cards, meal vouchers, telephone cards, etc.

JCB Card is the official credit card of Tokyo Disneyland.

If you'd rather get a FASTPASS than wait right then, just follow these simple steps:



- FASTPASS tickets do not guarantee entry to an attraction.
- Valid only at the designated attraction.
- Each FASTPASS ticket admits one Guest only. When getting FASTPASS tickets for everyone in your group, please bring each member's Passport.
- To get a FASTPASS ticket, you must have a valid Passport used for admission on the day of your visit.
- Only one FASTPASS ticket is issued at a time.
- Check your FASTPASS ticket to find out when you can get a FASTPASS for another attraction. Please note that you cannot get a second FASTPASS ticket for the same attraction until after the period of time for using the first ticket has passed.
- FASTPASS ticketing may end earlier at some attractions than at others.

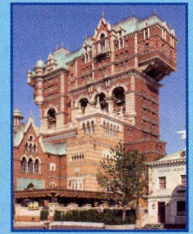
