

Thursday, June 3:

- 8:12 AM - take train from Salzburg Hbf to Innsbruck Hbf
 - <http://www.bahn.de/international/view/en/index.shtml>
 - Take RE 30016 from Salzburg Hbf to Rosenheim arriving at 9:28 AM.
 - Depart at 10:12 AM on EC 85 and arrive at Innsbruck Hbf at 11:23 AM.
 - Reserved at €38 + €5 fee for total of €43.
 - Code = N4QHNQ
- 11:23 AM - arrive and store luggage at station
 - Lockers are €2 for a small, €2.50 for a medium, and €3.50 for a large.
 - Get two mediums and one small.
- 11:45 AM – get lunch
- Buy the Innsbruck Card
 - http://www.innsbruck.info/xxl/_site/innsbruck/_lang/en/_area/478344/_subArea/478358/index.html
 - €25 per person for 24 hours of use.
 - Will save admission to Swarovski, all transportation, and the Bell Museum.
 - Total saved per person is €23 without the local transportation costs including the sightseer bus and the bus to Swarovski.
- 1 PM - Bus from train station to Swarovski
 - catch a red bus at Stop 1 at the train station, roundtrip
 - with the Innsbruck card, a free trip on a shuttle leaves Hbf at 9 AM, 11 AM, 1 PM, 3PM and leaves attraction at 11:30 AM, 1:30 PM, 3:30 PM, and 5:30 PM
 - Averages 2 hours for waiting between arrival and departure at Swarovski
 - Example: Leave train station at 1 PM, arrive at Swarovski by 1:15 PM, leave Swarovski at 3:30 PM, arrive at train station at 3:45 PM
 - €8.50 per person without the card
- 1:15 PM - Swarovski Crystal Worlds
 - 9 AM to 6 PM.
 - Address: Kristallweltenstrasse 1, Watten Innsbruck Austria
 - €9.50 per person
 - Covered by the Innsbruck Card
- 3:30 PM - Bus back to Innsbruck
- 4 PM - Glockengiesserei Grassmayr - Bell Foundry and Museum
 - Monday - Saturday, 9 AM to 5PM.
 - Covered by the Innsbruck Card.
 - Normal cost is €5 per person
- 5 PM - Pick up luggage and grab supper
- 6:36 PM - take train from Innsbruck Hbf to Munich Hbf
 - Take EC86 from Innsbruck Hbf, platform 6, leaving at 6:36 PM and arriving in Munchen Hbf, platform 13, at 8:25 PM.
 - Cost is €38 + €5 fee.

- Code = YK7RE9
- 8:25 PM – arrive at Munchen Hbf



- Buy the week long IsarCard
 - €14.50 per person for 1 Mon-Sun, for circles 1-3.
 - This is the one to purchase.
 - Planned trips covered by this is €16.80 per person.
 - Circles 1-6 (covering Dachau) would be €22.70 each.
- 8:40 PM - Take U-Bahn U2 from Hauptbahnhof München to Messestadt Ost (last station)
 - Subway leaves every 10 minutes

 - Normal single ticket is €2.40 each.
 - Covered by the IsarCard.
- 9:02 PM – arrive Messestadt Ost
 - 22 minute trip
